我們兩人的相遇?



dpi: Where did you get inspiration from?

靈感從哪來呢?

We moved out of the city in 2001 to the country. Our ideas about 'nature' took a dark turn through the long winters of isolation that we experienced there. The undeniable transformational power of a snow storm is such that one has this feeling of being housebound as if in a boat at sea. Another aspect of our experience with nature that has influenced our work is that to walk into the woods (at least these woods) is to leave the world of rules and predictable behavior behind and to enter a sort of shadow world of dark possibilities. That would of course not only include potential encounters with large bears, rattlesnakes or wolves but more frightening the humans with guns that hunt them.

dpi: What imaginations will you create in the future ?

It is hard to say of course what we will do in the future. We are so influenced by our experience that one would have to know what is coming to predict ones reaction to it. I suppose we will continue working along the same lines that we have established. We have developed a sort of particular language over time which can be used to express new things but in such a way as to maintain some continuity with our own history.

dpi: Anything you want to share about the process of the exhibition ?

For us the exhibition is not the most important part of the process. The excitement is always in the studio when new things occur or especially when something unexpected occurs that opens up a new door of possibility for the work. The biggest kick for us as artists is to watch almost as spectators as the work defines itself in surprising ways as a result of unexpected turns.

Rule of thumb; always be willing to drop an initial idea if a better one presents it-

dpi: Do you have any funny story which while you were creating your art works? 分享一個有趣的經驗吧?

How about a horror story instead? We installed an entire show of very fragile skeleton figures in a gallery with old wood flooring. An hour before the show opened a very fat critic came in for a preview, the stepped on one of the looser boards of the floor with such force that the skeleton figure at the other end of that board was catapulted off the floor and crashed down into a heap of parts. Cement floors are better.

dpi: What kind of art is your favorite? 對於藝術的喜好?

We are very fond of the Flemish painters of the 16th century and earlier. Pieter Brueghel, Hieronymus Bosch and Joachim Patinir. We love the English caricature of the late 18th century; Nixon, Giliray, Cruishank, and Rowlandson. We also love some of the French caricaturists of the 19th century particularly Grandville's wonderful animal human hybrids. We admire Francisco Gogo and we often go see his work in "El Prado" when we are in Madidi. Compositionally we are influenced by Chinese landscape scroll painting from the 14th to the 17th century.
